Q: What specific requirements are there to become an instructor for the NDOC?

A: To become an instructor they must first go through our volunteer training and have their curriculum approved by our Program Review Committee. Curriculum must also be evidence based/best practice. Or be a school District employee with the credentials for teaching in a needed curriculum.

Q: Can undocumented individuals participate in the NDOC vocational programs?

A: Undocumented individuals are allowed to participate in our vocational programs as long as they are working towards their HS diploma.
