Statewide partnership will provide every middle and high school public and charter classroom with exposure to career pathways via professionals from across industries.

Las Vegas / Carson City, NV (August 18, 2021) — Nepris, an online, cloud-based platform that virtually connects students with industry professionals all over the U.S., announces a multi-year partnership with the Nevada Department of Education (NDE) and the Nevada Governor's Office of Workforce Innovation (GOWINN) to provide its career learning platform to all 567 middle and high schools, public or charter, in the state.

"This state-wide partnership demonstrates Nevada's commitment to preparing all of its students for the future of work," said Sabari Raja, Nepris co-founder and CEO. "According to the Entangled Solutions white paper, <u>Unlocking Career Potential: An Analysis of the Career Navigation & Guidance Product Landscape</u>, only 1/3 of students believe they will graduate with the skills they need to acquire a good job, and 41% of recent graduates are underemployed. By providing career exposure and guidance at an early age, our educational systems and institutions develop a foundation for each students' social and economic mobility."

Nevada's participation with Nepris fulfills 2 statewide initiatives: The NDE Statewide Plan for the Improvement of Pupils (STIP)'s mission to improve student achievement and educator effectiveness and the Nevada Governor's Office of Workforce Innovation (GOWINN) initiative supporting the workforce pipeline through apprenticeships and work-based learning opportunities. Both the NDE and GOWINN have responsibility and accountability for supporting the workforce pipeline through apprenticeships and work-based learning opportunities.

"Using Nepris to connect Nevada students to industry professionals working in high-growth and high-demand fields directly aligns with our State's economic development and workforce development plans. I am excited to see this initiative come to life, and I look forward to continued partnership between our education system and our workforce." said Governor Sisolak. These industry pros speak with students about their jobs and serve as real-world success stories about the power of education and the doors that will be open to them upon graduation. The live sessions can include live demonstrations, student Q&A, mock interviews, virtual field trips or even critiques of student projects. Sessions give students a glimpse at possibilities and the necessary information to pursue their goals, regardless of socioeconomic status or geographic location. Nepris works in a variety of engagement models, whether the school is in-person, virtual, or a hybrid of both models.
