


Nevada State Industry Sector Councils

Mission: Provide the space for Nevada employers to engage in facilitated conversations regarding industry opportunities and challenges that will guide state workforce development strategy and activity.

Defined: Assemblies of employers, organized labor, post-secondary education, or other relevant groups or individual that identifies as part of or supportive of the related industry sector. The active sectors include:



Deliverable: The councils will provide the following:

- 1. Make recommendations to the Governor's Workforce Development Board to guide system alignment with local workforce boards
- 2. Verification of labor market information and job posting data
- 3. Direct feedback on education and training programs
- 4. Feedback on high-value credentials
- 5. Letters of support for programs and grant applications
- 6. Proposals for policy adjustment/implementation and provide a unified sector voice to testify on proposed policy
- 7. Opportunities to build on strengths and close gaps articulated in Nevada's Plan for Recovery and Resilience

How: Business is convened at the center of the conversation. Roundtable introductions should include the top hard/urgent-to-fill role and other barriers, including non-workforce-related priorities.
