NPWR Department of Labor Grant

- \$2.9 million Department of Labor grant
 - Submitted on May 10
 - Expected to receive application status by July
- Project goals include:
 - 1. Develop, expand, and modernize the collection of data around supportive services from nonprofits, wraparound public goods, credentials of value and industry recognized credentials, and apprenticeships
 - 2. Strengthen partnerships with UNLV and UNR to provide data analysis, publish academic reports and scorecards, and provide policy recommendations; expand on inaugural NPWR research grants
 - 3. Democratize data through building and implementing four dashboards that improve the quality of workforce data





Partnership to Advance Youth Apprenticeship (PAYA) Policy Academy Grant

- \$50,000 NGA Center for Best Practices grant
 - Submitted June 9
 - Expected to receive application status by July
- Project goals include:
 - 1. Assessing the current youth apprenticeship framework in the State and develop a unified statewide vision
 - Utilize NPWR to show trends in current education and workforce data and identify new metrics for tracking program outcomes and effectiveness
 - 3. Establish a statewide youth apprenticeship governance structure and develop a resource hub for students, parents, employers, training providers, labor, education, and government partners
