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Data Source Overview

• Current Population Survey (CPS)

- Conducted monthly
- Focused on employment / unemployment
- Small sample size

American Community Survey

- Conducted annually
- Broader population survey including income, healthcare, housing
- Larger sample, but at least 1 year lag

Administrative data

- Can be direct from program, or through NPWR
- Limited to what is collected by program or ability to join data
- Not population-wide limited perspective based on participation





American Community Survey

- Available as 1-year or 5-year data
 - 1 year data only available for geographic areas with a population of at least 65,000.
 - 2022 data currently available in 1-year estimates
 - 2017-2021 5-year estimates are most recent published.


• Wide variety of geographic data available:

- States, counties, Census-designated places, congressional districts, state legislative districts, school districts, ZIP code tabulation areas (ZCTAs), public-use microdata areas (PUMAs)
- PUMAs try to link similar areas but with population of roughly 100,000.





Nevada PUMAs








Examining Male Unemployment

- Data by grouped PUMAs in three regions
- Filtered to only male population
- Age limited to 20-64
- Data only shown where estimate is 3x the estimate's standard error.
- Even using ACS data, ability to cross-tabulate data is limited.










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1-Year ACS: Hispanic or Latino



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



• More comprehensive data, but spans 2017-2021, so includes impacts of the recession.
















