• 2,821 job seekers registered in December is 41.23% lower than the planned goal of 4,800. The improving economy with less people looking for work is reflected in a significant decline in the unemployment insurance rate (5.4% in November 2023). Additionally, December historically report lower registrations due to the holidays.

Program Initiatives

- Grow with Google: Pilot program completes January 27, 2024.
- ROADS: The new contract between DETR and WNC began November 1, 2023, and will go through October 31, 2027. Data on this new contract will be available on the
 next quarterly report as the contract was approved mid-Fall semester and Spring semester did not start until January 22, 2024. The ROADS program has also expanded
 to the College of Southern Nevada to offer students the same experience as the students from WNC, ensuring success in high-demand occupations with the Southern
 Nevada region.
- Early Childhood Education (ECE): The early childhood education accelerated programs are now available statewide. Through partnerships with Western Nevada College, Truckee Meadows Community College, College of Southern Nevada,
- Coursera: As of December 31, 2023, there was a total of 10,145 enrolled participants accessing the LearnNV Coursera platform for their training needs. With plans for various in-person and virtual events in the works, we anticipate the enrollment numbers to continue to increase with completion data forthcoming.
