
HENDERSON* SKILLS GAP ANALYSIS

In 2024, the City of Henderson partnered with Hickey Global, a nationally recognized economic development consulting firm, to produce a continuation of the work in the City of Henderson's Target Industry Analysis that identifies the top occupations for growth and the coinciding gaps in skills. The Henderson Skills Gap Analysis is broken into four parts: Executive Summary, including key findings and strategic recommendations; Industry Growth Assessment, which verifies and projects growth in Henderson's target industries; Gap Analysis, which measures the gap between Henderson's projected growth and that of the U.S.; and Skills Index, which indexes the skills gap of targeted occupations.






Note: Chart projects growth for jobs within the City of Henderson's target industries from 2023 to 2028 at the national and local level, showing the net difference in growth.
